



Los Alamos Farmers Market - RETAIL BOOTH APPLICATION

Appropriate for vendors who wish to sell at the Los Alamos Saturday Farmer's Market /Themed Retail Market pilot program.

DATES

From mid-June to September in 2023, the Saturday Farmer's Markets will be complemented by themed retail markets as follows:

June 2023 (<i>Saturday, June 17 & 24</i>):	Bikes & Biking Equipment
July 2023 (<i>Saturdays July 1, 8, 15, 22, 29</i>):	Sports Equipment
August 2023 (<i>Saturdays August 5, 12, 19, 26</i>):	Toys & Games
September 2023 (<i>Saturday, September 2 only</i>):	Fiber & Quilting

RULES & REGULATIONS

- a) Items for sale must be related to the theme and can be new or used.
- b) Used items must be in working condition and complete. No broken or "can-be-fixed" articles may be exhibited.
- c) Anything you bring to sell, and does not sell, you must take back with you. Your area at the market must be completely cleaned before leaving.
- d) You may not accept DUFEB or EBT coins. This program is for retail booths only.
- e) All tents must be weighted down (no stakes) and must meet or exceed New Mexico fire requirements.
- f) Vendors are required to be present for the duration of the market, from 8am-12pm and early break-down is not permitted.
- g) Applications are due at least a week prior to your date at the market, submitted to Cindy Talamantes, Market Manager. The Market Manager reserves the right to deny applications.

FEES

Daily Fee is \$45 per 10x10 square area. Tents are not provided and must be weighted down (no stakes). Make checks payable to Los Alamos Farmers Market.
